 b) Request a federal tax transcript from the Internal Revenue Service by calling 1-800-908-9946 (option 2 or 4), or visit [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov). Select Get Your Tax Return. Select Get Transcript Online or Get Transcript by Mail. Be sure to order a Return and not an Account.
2. Complete all sections of this worksheet and submit this form along with any documents (ie: tax transcripts) to our office. Please print when filling out this form.

### Family Information
